Activities ranging from clean ups to tree planting and educational activities were conducted throughout the year by St Andrew's Socioreligious Justice/Fraternity In Truth Inc. To celebrate their twentieth anniversary in 2009, JEAN organised the "The Bi-Annual Spring And Autumn Clean up Campaigns". Occurring in spring and autumn, the campaign attracted the support and participation of 35,000 volunteers at 268 clean up sites at beaches - including shoreline and underwater locations, alongside river banks, lakes and various inland sites. In addition to collecting waste, JEAN also recorded the amount and type of waste collected at the clean ups, to assess the amount of waste that is accumulating in marine environments. Approximately 500 volunteers took part in clean up and tree planting activities, organised by the Ho Chi Minh City (HCMC) Environmental Protection Agency, for their participation in Clean Up the World Weekend on September 26.
